Dear Student:

Welcome to the St. Dunstan CCD Program. Your teacher, classroom aides and I are happy to have you here at our program to share and learn about our faith. The following are some guidelines that your teacher will discuss with you regarding our program during class. We ask that you come to class as a willing and enthusiastic student and that all the guidelines mentioned below are followed at all times.

- Please be prompt when arriving for class. If you are late, please check in at the office *before* going to class.
- No food or drink will be allowed in the classrooms (please finish your afternoon snack *before* coming to CCD. (Exception: Class parties where food is provided by room parents.) **Absolutely no gum chewing at any time.**
- Please be sure to use the restroom at home *before* coming to CCD. Restrooms are available, however, class time is meant for learning about our faith.
- No caps/hats are to be worn during class.
- No electronic equipment (iPod's, walkman, video games, etc.) are allowed in CCD. Cell phones must be turned off. Use of cell phone during CCD will result in the cell phone being confiscated and given to the Director.
- No toys or sports equipment will be allowed in classrooms.
- Your instructor and aides are volunteering their time and are looking forward to instructing you in our faith. Please show respect to them always.
- We are fortunate to have use of the St. Dunstan School classrooms. Please show respect for your surroundings. Do not open or go through any of the classroom desks during your CCD class. Your teachers have a seating chart and will be able to determine who misused the classroom in the event that property has been misused or stolen. Show respect for these classrooms, as you would like to have someone do at your school classroom.

The most important guideline here at St. Dunstan CCD is to come to class with a smiling face and enthusiasm to learn and share about God. We are all here to help you grow in the spirit of Jesus.
